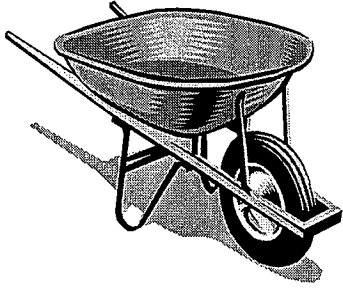


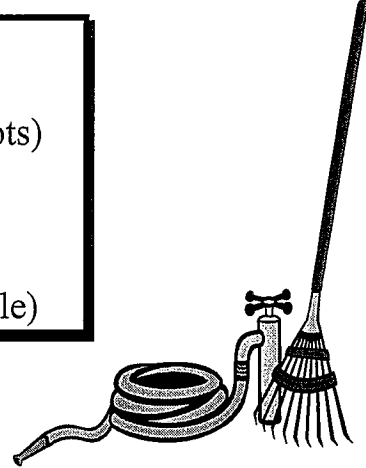
# CITY OF KEWANEE LANDSCAPE WASTE PROGRAM

## DO'S

These items can be put into landscape waste bags:



Grass & Weed Clippings  
Flowers  
Tops of Garden Vegetables (i.e. carrots)  
Tomato Vines & Bean Vines  
Leaves & Small Twigs  
Corn Husks (no cobs)  
Sod (shake off as much dirt as possible)



## DON'T S

These items cannot be put in landscape waste bags:

Vegetables & Fruits (includes apples)  
Corn Cobs  
Rocks, Wire & Any Metal Items  
Bottles, Cans & Plastic of Any Kind  
Paper & Cardboard  
Dead Animals & Animal Waste  
Dirt  
Acorns

**Bags must weigh less than 50 pounds.**

Landscape waste bag collection used generic, biodegradable Kraft paper bags intended to be used for landscape waste. Users may purchase bags at a retailer of their choice. A 50¢ City of Kewanee Excess Bag sticker must be affixed to each generic bag to be collected by the city. Stickers are available at City Hall, Beck Oil on 2<sup>nd</sup> St, Beck South, Farm King, JoJo's Store, CVS Pharmacy, Shell Express, Sullivan Foods, Walgreen's & Wal-Mart. Bags are picked up on Mondays only between the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in March and the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in December. If a holiday falls during the week, landscape waste will not be picked up that week. Bags should be set out on Sunday night and you can place an unlimited amount of bags at the curb as long as they have stickers applied. Small limbs & sticks placed in landscape bags cannot be longer than 1 ½'.
